## **«LIBERTINE»**

54% Vol. **Philippe Martin** 

### Nose

Fresh, spicy. Powerful yet mellow aroma.

### Palate

Intensive notes of wormwood, tangy but not bitter. Mild and smooth with a harmonious base note. Grande wormwood, dominant and slightly numbing on the tongue.

### Comment

Traditional absinthe with a predominant flavour of wormwood and anise. Fresh and spicy at the same time.

A true "La Bleu" for connoisseurs with excellent taste.

## **«SERAFINE»**

53% Vol. Réne Jeanjaquet

### Nose

Strong lemon balm note. Sweet and yet powerful. Fresh aroma.

### Palate

Initial sweetness, followed by a pleasantly bitter note. Dry and long-lasting finish. Wormwood and anise both unfolding their flavours. Slightly numbing on the tongue and the palate.

### Comment

Pleasantly smooth note with a strong finish. Contains more of everything and is still smooth and mild. Without the typical, powerful herbal flavour. A classic "La Bleue" made to an old recipe.



## **«APHRODITE»**

55% Vol. **Philippe Martin** 











### Palate Initial sweetness. Pleasantly smooth, with a fresh and spicy base note.

Interesting, lasting composition of flavours. Subtle flavours of wormwood and anise.

### Comment

Thanks to additional aphroditical herbs Aphrodite is a particularly refreshing luxury absinthe with wonderfully rich flavours. A very exciting distillate, blending tradition with modernity.

Varied herbal notes with ostensible vermouth. Fresh aroma.

### Palate

Strong taste yet pleasantly balanced with strong notes of vermouth and lasting bitterness. Strikingly smooth despite the high alcohol content.

### In short

With its pleasant bitterness, just as in the days of the Belle Epoque, this absinthe can be drunk with sugar according to an age-old ritual, which contributes to the charm and popularity of this mythical drink.

## **«SADE»**

### Nose

Prominent notes of lemon balm. Fresh and spicy. With varied flavours, yet still balanced.

### Palate

Initial sweetness, followed by a warm and strong bitterness. Rich, full bodied and well-rounded. Very complex and yet not heavy. Long finish with slight of bitterness.

### In short

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Strong flavours and complex aromas are typical for this Sade.

A harmonious and powerful absinthe. A true "Verte" made from twelve different herbs.

# ORIGINALLY

## **«BOHEME»**

66% Vol. Philippe Martin

### Nose

Minty-fresh, yet bitter. Harmoniously strong.

### Palate

Initially pleasantly sweet, smooth and mellow. This is followed by a long-lasting finish with strong vermouth.

### In short

Absinthe as it was before prohibition: a strong green colour, strong and bitter vermouth taste, bold and extremely substantial. Gives you a taste of Swiss tradition.

### Palate
